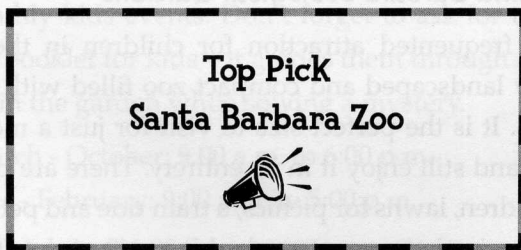

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### **Antique Carousel at Chase Palm Park**

One of the highlights of the Chase Palm Park is the carousel, which is protected from the beachfront climate by a beautiful carousel housing structure. The carousel was carved by Allan Hershell in 1919. It is 40 feet in diameter, has 36 intricately
